



2. Implementation Guidelines

O Process



- Venue for Finals: Government Complex Sejong, Building 15 (Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism), Auditorium (1F)
- Participants: A team of three students, enrolled in (or on a leave of absence from) a 2 or 4 year university
 - Participants and awardees from last competitions are also eligible (except grand award winners)
 - Each team can have only one student that meets the conditions below
 - · A student of foreign nationality attending a domestic university
 - · A Korean student attending an university overseas
 - · A student attending a foreign university in Korea
- Application: Via Online (<u>www.imo-contest.org</u>)
- O Presentation Topics: Safety, Environment, Regulations, Policy, Education, Logistics, etc.
- O Preliminary Round (Online, Deadline is September 28(Mon) Noon)



- Documents to be submitted via online
- (1) Application Form and Presentation Abstract (Brief information on team and an abstract of the presentation should be submitted in both Korean and English)
- (2) Powerpoint File (Solutions on the selected topic should be submitted in Microsoft Powerpoint in English; size should be less than 30mb)
- (3) Video File (Presentation in English on the selected topic should be submitted in video file; length should be about 10 minutes; size should be less than 300mb)
- (4) University Certificate of Registration (Submit copies of University certificate of admission for all team members)

Environment	Prevention of marine pollution, Ways to reduce green house gas, Management of		
	maritime dangerous goods, Ballest Water Management(BWM), Ways to prevent		
	illegal waste disposal from ships, Environment-friendly ships and IMO		
	environment-related issue.

Topic	Examples	
Regulation	Compensation for oil spill damage, Implementation of Wreck Removal Convention, Maritime safety judgement or hull insurance-related issue, Unified implementation of convention and IMO regulation-related issue.	
Policy	IMO policy suggestion for implementation of UN Sustainable Development Goals, Ways to improve developing countries' capacity of implementing convention, Improvement of developing women workforce, Effective application of IMO Mandatory Audit Scheme(IMSAS) and IMO policy-related issue.	
Education	Ways to train mariners for their capacity development, Ways to improve education system of nurturing international professionals in shipping and IMO education-related issue.	
Logistics	Maritime Single Window for logistics & customs, Maritime cyber security, Ways to facilitate maritime logistics and IMO logistics-related issue.

4. Guidelines for Submission

O For the Preliminary Round

(1) Application Form and Presentation Abstract

- Application Form: fill out the required information including the team name, university,
 major, name and contact number of team members on the IMO official website
- Presentation Abstract: The abstract of presentation both in Korean and English should be submitted. Participants should comply with the prescribed form
- Korean '돋움' font 10points, English 'Arial' font 10points
- Do not exceed 1 page
- File Name and Extension : <u>2020IMO English Team Name.docx</u>
 Please name them in English

(2) Microsoft Powerpoint File

- Presentation material should be stated in English and submitted in PPT file format
- Cover and slide: "Blind Test" applies to the whole evaluation process. Therefore, it is prohibited to state personal information such as university, major or participants' name other than team name and presentation title on the cover and in the slides of PPT file.
- Size: There is no limitation on the number of slides (presentation time is limited to about 10 mins)
- Slide size: Follow basic format of MS PowerPoint (4:3, 25.4cm*19.05cm)
- File Name and Extension : <u>2020IMO_English_Team_Name.pptx</u>
 Please name them in English
 It should be in accordance with MS PowerPoint 2010-2016 version
- Keynote is not allowed
- Attaching videos or voice files in the PPT file is not allowed

- *The participating team qualifying for the finals is allowed to attach the video or voice file
- Font : Basic fonts offered by MS PowerPoint should be used. Unique fonts are not allowed
- PPT file size: less than 30mb
- Page number MUST be written in a slide

(3) Video File

- Make a video of the presentation in English using the PPT slides. The voice of the presenter should be clear
- The video clip should be limited to 10 minutes. All three individuals of the team should participate
- "Blind Test" applies to the whole evaluation process. Wearing an uniform implying a specific university or filming with a school background is strictly prohibited
- Video file size: less than 300mb
- File name and extension : <u>2020IMO_English_Team_Name.mp4</u>
 Please name them in English

(4) Certificate of Registration

- Submit a copy of the certificate of admission for all team members
- File Name and Extension: 2020IMO English Team Name(Team Members Name).jpg

O For the Finals

(1) Abstract

- The presentation scripts should be stated in English and submitted by adopting the same document format IMO actually uses. The format can be downloaded on the official web site.

(2) PPT File

- The participating team should provide the updated version of PPT file submitted for the preliminaries in terms of both contents and time duration (15 mins, less than 30MB)
- * Deadline for the finals: October 27 (Tue) 12:00PM

O Remarks

- Any work that fails to comply with the guidelines may be subject to disadvantages in evaluation
- All submissions will not be returned and the copyright of all submissions and award-winning works shall be vested in The Mock IMO Assembly
- The participating team should be composed of three individuals. A team of two or four is not allowed
- Each team can have only one student that meets the conditions below
 - · A student of foreign nationality attending a domestic university
 - · A Korean student attending an university overseas
 - · A student attending a foreign university in Korea
- Participants and winners of previous competitions can participate (except Grand Prize)
- Please upload the relevant files at least three hours before the deadline in case of technical issues
